She had a severe pressure sore on her heel, and various other issues which left her at high risk of needing an amputation from the knee down. On top of this she was very depressed, distressed and declined any support from the care assistants. I worked very closely with her, encouraging her to move, and spend time in bed as opposed to her chair and then supported her to purchase a mobility scooter to help her get around. Within weeks she was out and about in our communal areas, eating in the restaurant and socialising with staff and residents alike. Her quality of life changed entirely, and it is truly amazing to be part of transformations like that, helping people get the most out of their circumstances.
